How to Apply

We offer two different Tracks to apply for admission to the Freiburg Rising Stars Academy. In **Track 1**, candidates will apply directly for collaboration with one of our Host Principle Investigators. In addition some of our partner institutions also offer **Track 2**. This allows for an application without choosing a Host Principle Investigator but requires close familiarization with the collaborative research group with which prospective rising stars plan to work. Track 2 is open early career researchers from PhDs to Group Leaders.

The **Freiburg Rising Stars Conference** – as the first and main in person event - will take place **March 11-15, 2024**. Attendance of the conference week, which includes workshops, talks, networking events and – most importantly – time with their host PIs and in the research infrastructures, is mandatory for all Rising Stars. Travel and accommodation is provided at no cost to the Rising Stars selected for the Academy.

The **Rising Stars in Residence** will take place individually between May and October 2024. Selected Rising Stars will receive up to 5.000 € in mobility grants.
